The Aldeburgh Junior Open
Friday 29th July 2022
Tee times: 12.00-2.30pm

- The Aldeburgh Junior Open will be played on Aldeburgh's Championship Course, ranked in the top 50 courses in England
- Entries are Open to visitors and Aldeburgh members, male or female, under the age of 18 on 1st January 2022 and with a handicap of 28 or better for boys and 36 or better for girls.
- There will both handicap and scratch prizes. Prizegiving will be on the Terrace at around 6pm.

Entry fee:

£30 per player to be paid by BACS to Barclays Bank (a/c number 80116629; Sort Code 20-98-07) quoting the player's surname + JuOp. The entry fee covers prizes and includes a meal for each entrant after play. Parents/guardians and supporters are welcome to purchase food and drink at the club throughout the day. Please let the club know in advance if you have any special dietary requirements.

Entries will not be accepted until payment has been received and refunds will not be given to anyone who withdraws later than seven days before the event. We will send a confirmation email with more details on the day nearer the event. A £5.00 administration fee will be retained for anyone withdrawing earlier than that date but after the closing date. If the event is cancelled, we will issue a full refund.

Closing date:

Final entries must be received by 5pm on Monday 18th July 2021. The starting sheet will be published on the AGC website - www.aldeburghgolfclub.co.uk. (Visitors/Competitions/Open Competitions/Junior Open). It will also be sent to the registered players by e-mail at the start of the following week.

Size of field:

Entry limited to 50 players; if over-subscribed there will be a ballot on handicap.

Trolleys and caddies:

Trolleys are permitted. Caddies are not permitted.

Supporters:

Parents, relatives and friends are welcome to watch but must keep their distance and cannot provide any specific assistance or instruction to any player.

Supporters are reminded to be respectful of all players at all times, and to encourage all the juniors playing.
