We are not playing an additional 9 holes foursomes this year so that we can accommodate an extra 16 players (8 pairs) thereby giving more people the opportunity to play the new layout including four wonderful new holes which opened for play on 12th September 2025. We expect to revert to the previous format in 2027.

Entries will be accepted in pairs only - the first 30 pairs (60 players) to apply will be in the field with later entries in reserve. The final field will comprise 32 pairs (64 players) with the additional spaces filled by past winners invited by the Club or by reserves if these spaces are not filled.

Practice rounds: anyone wishing a practice round during the week before the event will pay a visitor's green fee at the County Card rate (£105) whether or not they have County Cards.
