Open to Amateur Golfers - Maximum Handicap Index: 8.0

Entry fee: £80 (£40 for members of the club) to be paid by BACS to Barclays Bank (a/c number 80116629; Sort Code 20-98-07)

Entry limited to 48 players; if over-subscribed, there will be a ballot on handicap. Competitors must be 16 years of age or older on the date of the event.

Closing date: 31st May 2026 following which the starting sheet will be published on the club's website (www.aldeburghgolfclub.co.uk) and e-mailed to competitors. Practice rounds will be available during the week of the event charged at the club's member's guest rate (£40).

Prizes: the Seaton Robson Trophy will be presented to the competitor returning the best net score over 36 holes; there will also be 36 holes scratch prizes and 18 holes handicap prizes for morning and afternoon rounds. No competitor may win more than one prize.

Ties: ties over 36 holes will be determined on the best second round – if the tying players have the same score in the second round or over 18 holes, the winner will be determined on the basis of the best score for the last nine holes (holes 10 - 18), last six, last three and finally the 18th hole.

Entries will not be accepted until payment has been received and refunds will not be given to anyone who withdraws later than seven days before the event.

DRESS CODE – tailored shorts may be worn with long socks; short socks may not be worn with shorts on the course or in the clubhouse. The Club recommends that golfers should change out of their golf shoes after they have played although clean golf shoes are permitted in the public rooms in the Clubhouse provided that they do not have spikes or ridges that might damage carpets and other floor surfaces.
